

ACCESSING THE STAAR STUDENT PORTAL FOR TEST RESULTS

STEP 1: Go to www.texasassessment.com



STEP 2: Enter the student's six character Unique Access Code that appears on their most recent STAAR Report Card. The code must be entered exactly as it appears. Then, enter the student's date of birth.

IF YOU DO NOT KNOW THE UNIQUE ACCESS CODE:

Click on "→Find My Unique Student Access Code" (located at the bottom of the purple square on the screen)

STEP 3: In the new screen that appears, enter the requested information in the appropriate fields:

- Student's first name (NOTE: it will only take the first 10 characters of the student's first name)
- PEIMS ID (social security number or state-assigned number)
- Date of birth
- Click the blue "GO" button

- The Unique Access Code will then be generated on the screen (NOTE: the Unique Access Code remains the same for the student from year to year)
- Click the blue “GO” button AGAIN to get the results.

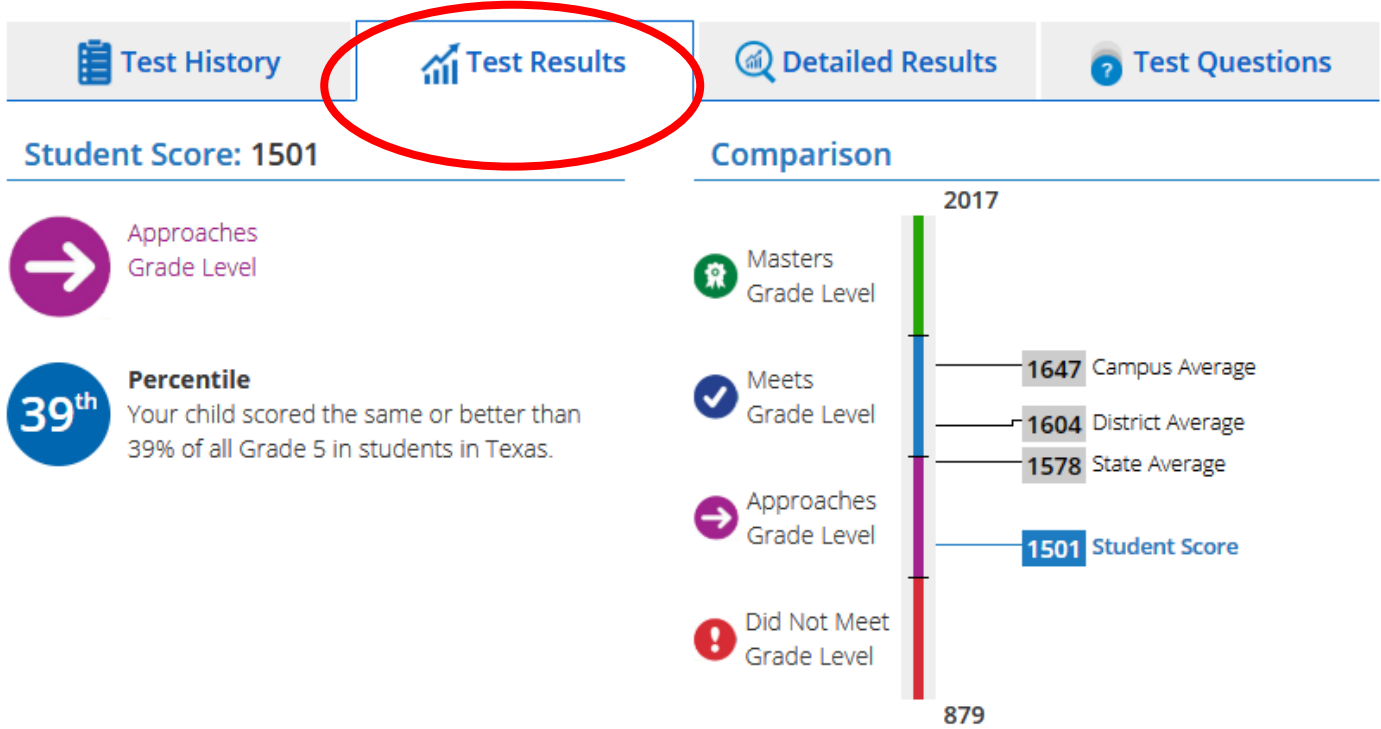

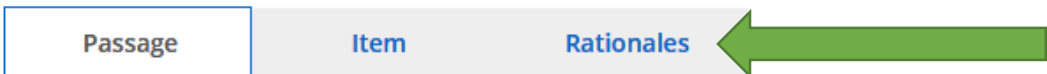
