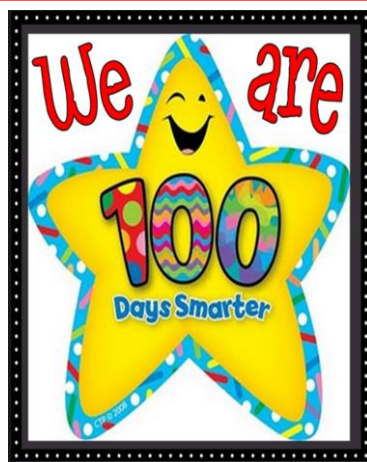

## *Message from our Health Aide*

Hello Parents!

Our health team would like to thank everyone for their help with keeping our scholars healthy. Just wanted to share some information flyers and some tips! Keep up the great work and thank you for sending your children to school!

1. Parents medication should not be given to students to carry; all meds should be stored in health clinic with a proper form signed and/or with physician's paperwork.
2. Rashes and any abnormal skin condition or pink eye should be reported to us immediately. We want to prevent school wide infections.
3. Please do not allow unhealthy snacks to be brought by your child..... note: it has been known that Takis, Hot Cheetos and any other type of spicy chips can cause the stomach lining to erode, hence children with stomach aches and emergency room visits. (flyer attached regarding smart snacks)
4. Lice is easily spread when proper precautions are not taken. Encourage kids to not share hats, scarfs, jackets, hairbrushes or headphones. Please treat your scholar if you see evidence of eggs or lice. (please see attachment)
5. Encourage fluids and hand washing as well as covering mouth when coughing and sneezing!
6. Parents we have seen many children both elementary and secondary without jackets during these cold weather days, please encourage your child to cover up!

Many of these simple things can help minimize absences and keep all of us healthy!

Nuestro equipo de salud quiere agradecer a todos por su ayuda a mantener sanos nuestros alumnos. ¡Sólo quería compartir algunos folletos de información y algunos consejos! ¡Sigán con el gran trabajo y gracias por enviar a sus hijos a la escuela!

1. Todo medicamento deben guardarse en clínica de salud con una forma firmada o con papeles del médico. Cualquier pregunta llámenos.
2. Erupciones o problemas de la piel o condición anormal deben ser comunicados a nosotros inmediatamente. Igual que condiciones anormales de los ojos, (conjuntivitis) etc.. Queremos prevenir infecciones.
3. Por favor no permita que comida chátara sea traída por su hijo... Nota: se ha sabido que Takis, Hot Cheetos y cualquier otro tipo de patatas fritas picantes pueden erosionar el revestimiento del estómago, y causando niños con dolores de estómago y urgencias visitas. (flyer adjunto sobre bocadillos)
4. Los piojos se propaga fácilmente cuando no se toman las precauciones adecuadas. Anima a los niños a no compartir sombreros, bufandas, chaquetas, cepillos para el cabello o auriculares. Por favor tratar a su hijo con medicamentos si ve evidencia de los huevos o los piojos. (ver archivo adjunto)
5. Recomienden que tomen suficiente agua. ¡Y aconsejen lavado de las manos constantemente igual que cubrir la boca al toser y estornudar!
6. ¡Padres hemos visto muchos niños de primarias y secundarios sin chaquetas durante estos días de frío, por favor anime a su hijo para encubrir!

¡Muchas de estas cosas simples pueden ayudar a reducir al mínimo las ausencias y mantener todos más sanos!
