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## Message from our Health Aide



Dear Carver Parents:

Head lice, although not an illness or a disease, is very common among children and is spread through head-to head contact during play, sports and when children share things like combs, hats, brushes, and headphones. Please treat your child this evening prior to returning to school tomorrow. Treatment information can be found on the bottom of page. It is recommended that all clothing, bed linens, and other items worn within 2 days before treatment be treated. It is also recommended that household members be checked and treated the same day. According to the Centers for Disease Control and the American Academy of Pediatrics, children diagnosed with live head lice can return to school once treatment has begun. Nits may persist after treatment, but kill crawling lice. The Centers for Disease control and Prevention can be utilized as a resource for treatment and prevention of lice. Here are a few tips on lice.....

- Check their children's hair for head lice on a weekly basis.
  - Treat an infested child as soon as possible after lice have been identified.
  - Inspect household members regularly.
  - Notify the school and the parents of close friends if they have identified head lice in their children, to make sure that if the lice were transmitted, treatment can start as soon as possible.
  - Notify the school of the treatment procedures you have followed so that your child can attend school if the school has a no-lice or no-nit policy in place.
  - Make sure that children with long hair attend school with hair tied back.
- Be willing to attend head lice information sessions or meetings organized by the school.
